1 BY MAIL

Want to Vote-By-Mail?

For your convenience, any registered voter may vote by Vote-By-Mail ballot. A voter, member of the voter's immediate family or legal guardian may request a Vote-By-Mail ballot in person, by mail or by telephone. One request is deemed sufficient to receive a Vote-By-Mail ballot for all elections through the end of the calendar year of the next regularly scheduled general election.

Requests for Vote-By-Mail ballots must be made no later than 12 days prior to Election Day. All voted Vote-By-Mail ballots must be in the Supervisor's Office by 7 p.m. on Election Day, in order to be counted.

Signature Update

Any time there is a change in your signature or identifying "mark", you must complete a new registration application & submit it to the Elections Office. If your signature on your voter record and the signature on your Vote-By-Mail ballot do not match, your Vote-By-Mail ballot will not count.

How To MAKE YOUR VOTE COUNT

Our tabulation system uses an optical scanner to read your ballot.

You must completely fill in the oval for your vote to count.
